

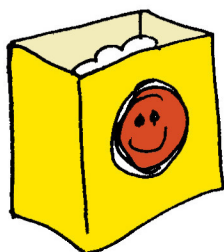
MEET THE INGREDIENTS...

Hi, we're plain old liquid soap.

Regular dishsoap or Dr. Bronner's. Use us with water for washing dishes and mopping the floor—no need to buy toxic cleaners! If you want bubbles, add water to soap. If you don't want bubbles, add soap to water.

Hi, I'm Baking Soda.

I'm THE best natural scrubber for soap scum and greasy gunk. Keep me in a shaker jar (think parmesan cheese) by your sink to sprinkle on pots and pans. Spray with Cleaning Spray and let sit while you're having dinner... then wipe clean!

Hi, I'm Tea Tree Oil.

I'm a natural antiseptic and Australia's favorite germ-killer. Keep me handy in your medicine cabinet for pimples and bug-bites, and add me to your cleaners!



MIX THE CLEANERS...



All-Purpose Cleaning Spray

Made with 3 Tbsp. liquid soap and water. Soap and water get most of the germs—and ALL of the dirt! Use everywhere. Add 10-20 drops scented oil if desired.

(alkaline ph)

Disinfecting Cleaning Spray (alkaline ph.)

Add 20-30 drops of Tea Tree Oil to the All-Purpose Cleaning Spray to kill the rest of the germs. Great for bathrooms!



(acid ph)

Squeaky Cleaning Spray

Mix half vinegar and half water in a squirt bottle (add 10-20 drops peppermint oil or tea-tree oil to boost cleaning power and mask the "pickle" smell). Great for floors and neutralizing soap sprays.
